## **WARF Leisure Pool Rules:**

---

*To ensure a safe and enjoyable environment, the following guidelines for the Leisure Pool are in effect:*

1. All patrons must shower before entering pool.
2. Patrons known or suspected of having a communicable or skin disease, open wounds, inflamed eyes, nasal or ear discharge, are not allowed in the pool.
3. Appropriate swim attire is required. Street/Gym clothing is not permitted.
4. Non-toilet trained children must wear a swim diaper.
5. Food, gum, glass, or open top drinks are not permitted in the pool area.
6. Enter the pool from the beach access or stairs only. Entrance of any kind from the side of the pool is prohibited, including but not limited to diving, pushing, and jumping.
7. Children 48 inches or less must be accompanied by a guardian (16+ years old) who is within arm's reach in the pool.
8. Children ages 5 and under must be accompanied by a guardian (16+ years old) who is within arm's reach in the pool.
9. Only U.S. coast Guard Personal Flotation Devices (PFD's) are permitted, and an adult must be within arm's reach of anyone using a PFD in the pool.
10. Do not climb onto the Island or on the wall separating the lazy river and beach area.
11. Swim lesson equipment (i.e., noodles, kickboards) are for aquatic programs only.
12. Pool items brought from home may be removed at the discretion of the aquatics staff.
13. Please report any injuries, incidents, or equipment problems immediately to staff.
14. Offensive language, inappropriate or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
15. Lifeguard staff may prohibit any behavior deemed unsafe or disruptive.
